English:

During term 2 teaching and learning programs in English will focus on learning about:

Imaginative Texts

- narratives and illustrations, rhymes and poems

Informative Texts

- reports, procedural texts, recounting events, maps, diagrams, tables, emails, greeting cards, short formal presentations

Persuasive texts

- arguments and expressing opinions

Reading Groups: students will continue to read and work with according to their levels.

Phonics, spelling and vocabulary: focuses will include phonics, frequently used words and subject specific vocabulary. Spelling tasks and word lists are differentiated to cater for varying needs of students. The focuses will continue to be sent home via the weekly class email.

Cooperative group work:

We will be learning how to work cooperatively in groups to research, gather and present information about Australian states, animals and significant sites.

Formal presentation:

Year 2 will be required to prepare a speech. Information about the topics will be sent home at the beginning of the term via our class newsletter.

Mathematics:

The focuses across year 2 for term 2 will be:

Number & Algebra: addition and subtraction, multiplication and division

Measurement & Geometry: two-dimensional space, three-dimension space, position

Statistics & Probability: chance

Human Society and its Environment (HSIE):

Geography

The focus will continue to be on exploring places across a range of scales within Australia and the world.

Students will learn about connections people, including Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples, have with places. We will study the text *Are We There Yet* by Alison Lester as part of this unit.
