Library

Each term, all Year 1 classes will be attending Library with Mrs Westoby. To ensure all our books stay clean, please encourage your child to pack their own library bag.

Scripture and Ethics

K-2 Scripture and Ethics lessons take place each Wednesday from 12.00-12.30pm. Scripture and Ethics classes are provided for Combined Protestant, Catholic, Jewish, Baha'i and Ethics. Students whose parents do not elect a Scripture or Ethics group will go to non-Scripture, where they will be supervised by a teacher.

School Reward System

Castle Cards, Merit Certificates and A-Day Awards are given throughout the year. Once your child receives 10 Castle Cards (CC's earned in Kindergarten can be used to make up the 10), please return them to the class teacher in a named envelope/zip lock bag, for a Merit Certificate (this will be handed out in class). 10 Merits (can also include any A Day awards) earn a Bronze Award, another 10, a Silver Award and a following 10, earns a Gold Award. This award system continues throughout a student's school life at Castle Cove.

Attendance/Late arrival and Early Leaving

If for any reason, your child is unable to attend school, you must provide written notification to the teacher, an email to the teacher, or a phone call to the office. An absent note must be provided to the school within 7 days of an absence, as school rolls are legal documents. If your child is late to school (i.e. after 9.25 am) or has to leave early, (i.e. before 3.25 pm) a 'Late Arrival' or 'Early Leavers' note MUST BE obtained from the school office and given to the class teacher or teacher on playground duty.

Excursions

Year 1 will take part in a number of incursions and excursions during the school year. These include a Science Incursion 'Fizzics', a visit to the Opera House, Life Education and Musica Viva. The whole school will also travel to Chatswood in the last week of the school year to attend the movies. Payment for these events will be included in your child's school fees. Permission notes will be sent home prior to the event. Please ensure all notes are returned promptly.

Home Readers Each student will be able to borrow an independent home reader on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays. Usborne books may be borrowed on Fridays only. Students choose their own readers (at their independent, 96+% accuracy, reading level) and any Usborne book. The Usborne books are meant to be a 'shared reading experience' at home.

Maths Mastery Badges A copy of the Maths Mastery Badge Book has been sent home. The Year 1 Maths skills are listed on the back. These skills should be achievable by the end of Year 1. These badges can be accessed via the CCPS website below.
